

FOOD WORDS: ONSET-RIME BLENDING

MATERIALS

- Food Words: Onset-rime cards
- Pencil
- Copies of real words / nonsense words recording sheet

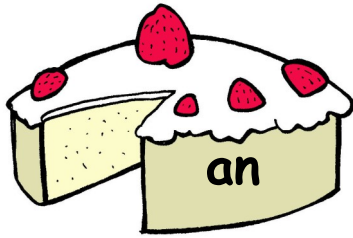
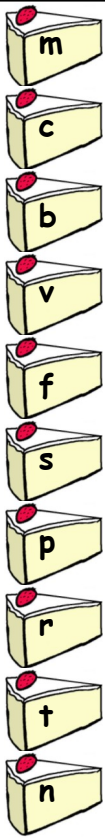
PREPARATION

- Make required number of copies of recording sheet

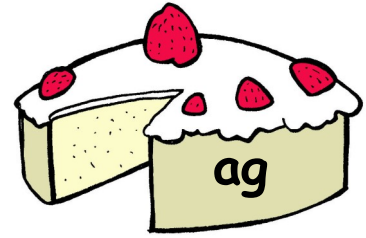
HOW TO PLAY

- The child reads the rime aloud.
- The child then says the first initial consonant (onset) and blends it with the rime. Encourage the child to read the word smoothly, rather than reading each sound individually.
- The child then decides if the word is a real word or a nonsense word and records it in the appropriate space.
- Optional: For an additional challenge the child can complete the task listed at the bottom of each rime card. Additional rime families can be practiced using the blank card - simply write your own onsets and rimes onto the slices of cake and the cakes.

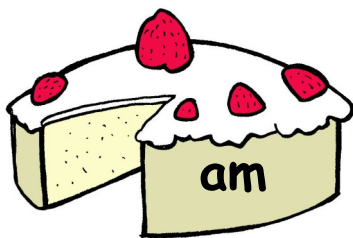
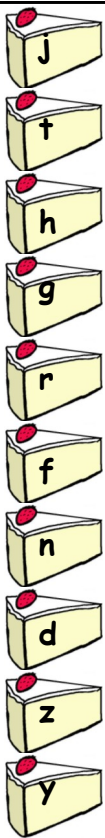
